LOCAL RULES BRIEF

1. OUT OF BOUNDS - OB

The course boundaries are determined when the ball passes through the concrete fence (left of hole 01), the edge of the cart path (left of holes 04, 05, 09, 10), over the edge of the grass (yellow tee at hole 05).

2. DROPPING ZONES

- If a player's ball is in the red penalty areas at holes 04 and 05, the player has the additional option of dropping the ball in the Drop Zone and incurring one penalty stroke. Note: At hole 05, apply the Drop Zone to the water area behind the green.
- If a player's ball is in the flower bed areas of hole 11, behind the tee box of hole 12, or left of the green hole 18, the player must take relief with one penalty stroke according to two options:
 - o Dropping the ball out of the landscape area to both sides in the direction the ball lies;
- o Dropping the ball into the Drop Zone at this hole.
- If a player's ball is in or on the landscape area behind the green of holes 02, 05, 09, 18 and the cart path behind the green of hole 18, the player must take free relief of the ball according to two options:
 - o Dropping the ball out of the landscape area to both sides in the direction the ball lies;
 - o Dropping the ball into the Drop Zone at this hole.

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS)

- The golfer is allowed to take free relief for all the abnormal ground conditions.
- Note: Balls lying on the embankment of holes 05, 06, 09, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18 are no free drop (this area is within the red penalty area according to Article 3 of this document).
- · Abnormal course conditions:
- The flower bed areas are marked with a green or red NO PLAY ZONE sign.
- o Abnormal course conditions outside the penalty area:
- √ Green NO PLAY ZONE sign at holes 02, 05, 09, 17: the player must take free relief.
- o Abnormal course conditions inside the penalty area:
- $\sqrt{\text{Red NO PLAY ZONE}}$ sign at holes 11, 13, 18: the player must take relief with one penalty stroke.
- $\sqrt{}$ If a player's ball is in or on the cart paths, rain shelters, drainage ditches, signs, sprinkler heads, electrical boxes, light poles, irrigation systems, trees with stakes,... in the red penalty area, the player is allowed to take free relief (in that penalty area).

4. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Movable obstructions include wooden stakes placed on the cart paths, wooden stakes used to guide the direction of the golf carts, and green stakes (with rope or not) used to protect the G.U.R grass areas.
